Emphasis on rhetoric and composition and the writing process. Establish college-level writing strategies. WritePlacer® Score of 5 or higher or passing grade in ENG091 is required.

CRW202 - The Writer as Witness (Sec. # 34661)

Wed 4:30-7 p.m. 01/16/2019 - 05/10/2019

Studio course focusing on writing with the writer as witness of the world: pre-writing, writing, analysis, evaluation, and writing. A grade of C or better in CRW150 or permission of Instructor.
