1. Summer School Structure and Earning Credit

- i. Summer school students will attend school in person.
 - i. Past and current enrolled ALA students will be accepted for summer school
 - ii. Mesa students verified by SCR staff will be accepted for summer school, NO EXCEPTIONS
- ii. Summer school will have two sessions:

Session 1: Week 1: Tues 5/30 – Fri 6/2 (*No school Monday, May 29*)
Week 2: Mon 6/5 – Thurs 6/8 (*No school Friday, June 9*)

Session 2: Week 1: Mon 6/12, Tues 6/13, Thurs 6/15 & Fri 6/16 (*No school Wednesday, June 14*)
Week 2: Tues 6/20* – Fri 6/23 (*No school Monday, June 19*)

*Tues 6/20: Session will end at 11:30 AM for the ALA Graduation Ceremony
- iii. Students may register for both sessions:
 - i. Session times are 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM
 - ii. Students will have a half hour lunch break: 12:00 – 12:30PM
 - iii. Breakfast and lunch will be available
- iv. Each student will be provided a laptop
- v. Students **must submit notes** in order to access quizzes and receive credit for the completed course
 - i. Each student will be provide guided notes for Edgenuity, if available

vi. Course class assignment

- i. ALA Students may be registered in one of the classes they did not complete during the spring quarter, ALA will determine the class.
- ii. Mesa Students will be assigned a class approved by Mesa Public Schools as credit recovery.

2. Attendance

- i. All students are required to attend the class for which they are scheduled.
- ii. After an accumulated 8 hours of unexcused absences, students will be dropped for lack of attendance. Attendance is taken daily for each session.
- iii. Students may also work outside of their scheduled class time.

2023 Summer School Student Agreement
ACCELERATED LEARNING ACADEMY

1. Open Campus Policy

- a. The ALA is a closed campus. Each student is expected to be on campus as assigned.

2. Attendance & Earning Credit

- a. Summer School runs four days a week beginning Tuesday, May 30th through Friday June 23rd. There are no classes on Wednesday, June 14th for Salt River.
- b. Students may register for both sessions:
 - Session 1: Week 1: 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM (8 hours)
Week 2: 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM (8 hours)
 - Session 2: Week 1: 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM (8 hours)
Week 2: 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM (8 hours)
- c. All students are required to attend the class for which they are registered.
- d. After an accumulated 8 hours marked as an unexcused absence during summer school, students will be dropped for lack of attendance. Attendance is taken every session on a daily basis.
- e. Students must remain on campus in their assigned classroom during their scheduled classes.

3. Signing In and Out

- a. If leaving campus for any reason, each student is required to notify the front office. Once back at campus, each student is required to check in at the front office.

4. Dress Code & Behavior

- a. Clothing must not denote gang affiliation through overt colors or symbols.
- b. Clothing may not contain any red or blue
- c. Clothing must not display drug or alcohol use & may not be revealing or see-through.
- d. Students may not be on campus if under the influence of any illegal substance. If medication is needed a doctor's note must accompany the student's medication; and must be turned into the school nurse.
- e. Students may not have any illegal substance in their possession while on campus. Failure to follow this will result in immediate dismissal from the program.
